- I. Call to Order 5:11 p.m.
- II. Establish A Quorum Board Members Present were: Lucy Sidoff, Doug MacEachen, Stephanie Stiles, and Carla Maciag. Mike Mahoney had a work obligation. Also present were Magda Hatka from AmeriTech and five (5) homeowners. Four (4) owners joined on Zoom.
- III. Approve and Waive the Reading of the Minutes of the January 20, 2025 Meeting **MOTION:** was made and seconded to approve and waive the reading of the January 20th Minutes with the correction of the date as January 20, 2025, was unanimous
- IV. Treasurer's January 2025 Report Doug MacEachen
  End of month cash on hand was \$1,709. Monthly Expenses were \$10,468, which was \$4,307 over budget.
  For the year we are \$4,307 over budget. The Reserve is \$134,583 of which \$4,158 is deferred maintenance.
  Over budget items are the result of making repairs from the hurricanes and repairs associated with the roof construction: Evans Landscaping \$2000; NatureZone \$1400; Lontakos Electric \$2750.

  MOTION: was made and seconded to accept the January 2025 Treasurer's Report with explanations, was unanimous

    - New T.V. was Donated by the Degan's We still need to buy a mount and hang it in ladies exercise room to be operated on ROKU streaming service

    - 1. Island Lighting Electrical issues from storms have been repaired; the Board agreed to continue maintenance upkeep on island; however, not to spend funds on additional lighting purchases
    - 2. Fishing Deck Proposal from Triad Engineering Currently under review and consideration

#### VIII. New Business

- A. Pressure Wash and Clean Clubhouse Roof We received three (3) bids and chose the lowest **MOTION:** was made and seconded for Magda to contact K.J. Pressure Washing to inquire about warranty for removing mold and staining on roof at \$1125 this year and \$450 next year, was unanimous
- B. Purchase of a New BBQ Grill Jim Rivers will turn in an invoice to Magda for partial reimbursement for the purchase of the grill; the board will pay for refilling of gas tanks from petty cash; reminder to users to pull the grill away from the wall and replace the cover after grill has cooled down
